TIMING FOR EVENTS TO BE FOLLOWED STRICTLY

- 1) They are required to wake up by 5.30 AM, our volunteers shall be there for wake up call.
- 2) Morning exercise timing is 6:00 AM to 7:00 AM (yoga/jumba/aerobics)
- 3) Tea/Breakfast 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM
- 4) Lunch 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM
- 5) Hi Tea 4.30 PM to 5:00 PM
- 6) Dinner 8:00 PM to 9:00 PM
- 7) Academic sessions from 9:15 AM to approximately by 4:00 PM
- 8) Cultural events/Interactive activities 6:00 PM to 10.30 PM.

WHAT THE CANDIDATES ARE REQUIRED TO BRING:

- 1) Please bring a water bottle.
- 2) Ironed cloths for all days, there is no dress code for candidates, but should be decent.
